- Attendance: 3 Unexcused absences = you have cut yourself from the team

### End Cap Rule:





POINTS OF EMPHASIS EYESHADE

The NFHS Boys Lacrosse Rules Committee has aligned with other sports to standardize the use of eyeshade. Eyeshade (grease or nonglare strips or stickers) shall be a single, solid stroke and may not include words, numbers, logos or other symbols.



ILLEGAL and now point of emphasis - 1min NON-RELEASEABLE Penalty

### Some More Rule Changes: Eye Black: only straight line



#### More POINTS OF EMPHASIS:

- Chin straps/helmet wearing properly
  - If comes off during play, you are removed and out until next dead ball/stoppage of play
- Arm Guards on elbows not biceps
- No body checking a player who is engaged in a face-off - YOU CAN stick check them legally
- Checks to head and neck area player safety focus
