

WHY ARE THERE JAGLAX BOOSTER CLUB FEES AND FUNDRAISERS?

As a Booster Club, we need every player in JagLax to help fund the program, not just during the season, but year round. Booster Club support benefits every single player in the program. Below are some examples of how Booster Club fees are utilized, in addition to a variety of other miscellaneous needs of the program year round:

- Off-season dome rental (unlike some other schools, Bloomington does not have a dome so we pay a premium price for dome rental during the off-season).
- Off-season winter coaching staff as well as supplementing over ½ the regular season coaching staff pay not covered by the school.
- Equipment including helmet subsidy to lower the cost to players, replacement uniforms (jerseys, gloves, socks), in-season player and coaches apparel (polo & shooter shirts, etc.), balls, nets, goals, cones, string, tape, etc.
- Year-end banquet, alumni game, senior night, and the yearbook.

Is a player able to play lacrosse at Jefferson if Booster Club fees are not paid?

Non-payment of Booster Club fees will prohibit a player from participating in any off-season Booster Club sponsored and administered off-season events. The player will not be able to participate in winter off-season training or any other opportunity sponsored and administered by the Booster Club. When it comes to a player participating in the regular high school lacrosse season, that decision falls completely within Coach Cater's purview. The Booster Club has no say in whether athletes can or cannot play high school lacrosse during the regular season based on payment of Booster Club fees. If reduced player fees are needed, please contact Coach Cater directly. He is the only person able to make scholarship decisions for the program. The Booster Club has implemented an optional program called "Shop with Scrip." Families can utilize the Shop with Scrip program as a personal fundraising opportunity to help pay for their individual Jefferson Boys Lacrosse Fees.
